



FAQ: Housing

Who arranges accommodation for the exchange students at Kristianstad University ?

The international Office takes care of the accommodation. Each exchange student coming to Kristianstad University is guaranteed a room in either one of the student dorms, where you share kitchen and bathroom with other students or in apartments which are to be shared by 2 students and then you often have your own kitchenette and bathroom.

Smoking is not allowed in the buildings!

How are the rooms/kitchen equipped?

At "Krebo", the rooms are to be shared by 2 students; each room has a kitchenette (equipped with basic kitchen utensils) and bathroom. Internet connection is included. The room size varies between 29-34 m². The rooms are equipped with bed, desk/table, chairs, lamps, blanket, pillow and closet.

At Brinova, 2 students share a room and there are common kitchens and bathrooms. Some rooms have their own bathroom. Internet is included in the rent. The room size varies between 17-21 m². The rooms are equipped with beds, mattresses, quilts, pillows, desk, chairs and lamps.

How much does a room cost?

Krebo: 2200-2500 SEK/person.

Brinova: 2300-2600 SEK/person

You will have to sign a Contract/Tenancy Agreement and pay a deposit of 4000 SEK after your arrival.

Please notice that there is a 3 months of notice period before you move out (Check your contract to make sure!)

NB! *Your future landlord might charge a deposit in connection with your taking up residence. The deposit may amount to at the most three monthly rents. The sum will be repaid in full after an executed and approved inspection of the flat. Your landlord will answer questions concerning a possible deposit charge and the state of the flat after your removal.*

How do I apply for an accommodation?

You have to fill in the Application for Accommodation in the online application at least 8 weeks before semester starts. You can also fill in your preferences for accommodation.

What is the distance to university and centre from my residence?

By walk from Brinova it takes about 35 minutes.

You can go by bus (monthly ticket costs about 300 SEK) but the most common way to go to the University is by bike. You can purchase a used bike for around 500-1000 SEK at a bike shop in Kristianstad.
