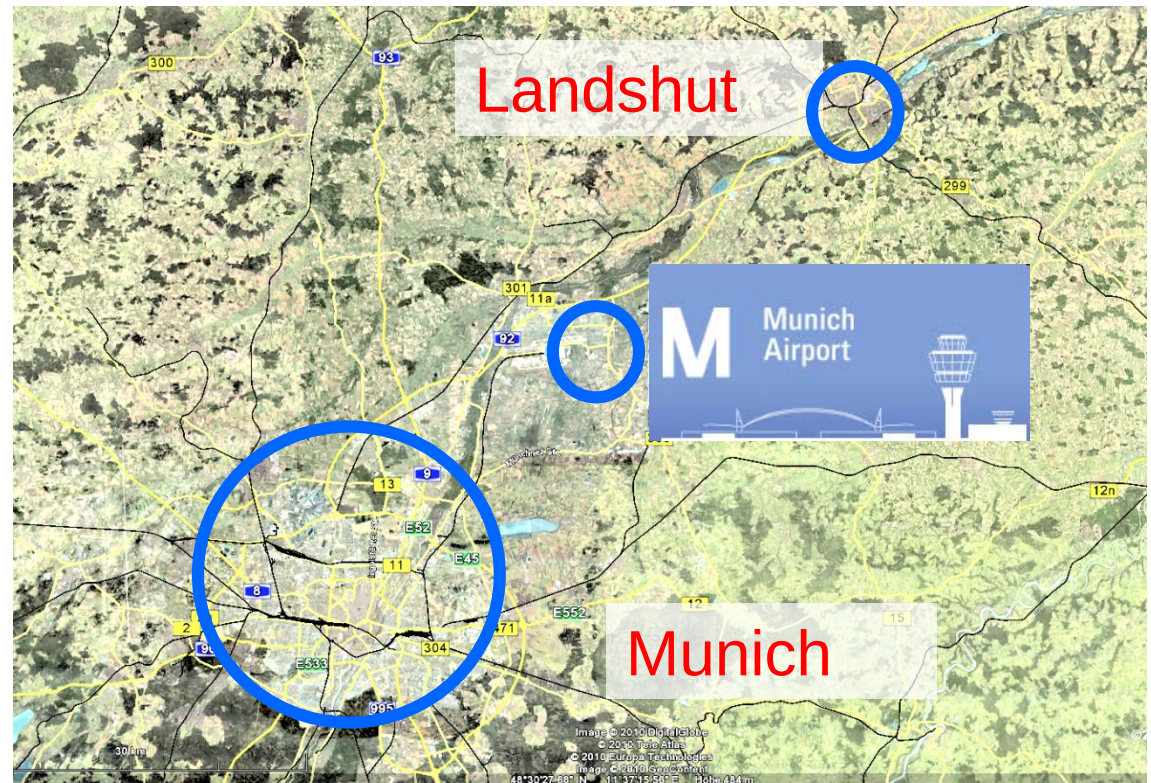


St. Martin's church

- Founded by Duke Ludwig I of Bavaria in 1204, Landshut remained the main seat of the House of Wittelsbach until 1255.
- Under the reign of the „Rich Dukes” Landshut witnessed a glorious period from 1393 to 1503, when it was the seat of government of the dukedom of Bavaria-Landshut.
- Every four years: the greatest European historic festival of the "Royal Wedding" = "Landshuter Hochzeit“, in which nearly 2.000 citizens of Landshut celebrate the 1475 wedding of the duke "Herzog Georg der Reiche" and the Polish King's daughter Hedwig.
- The city of Landshut had been the seat of government of Lower Bavaria since 1839.



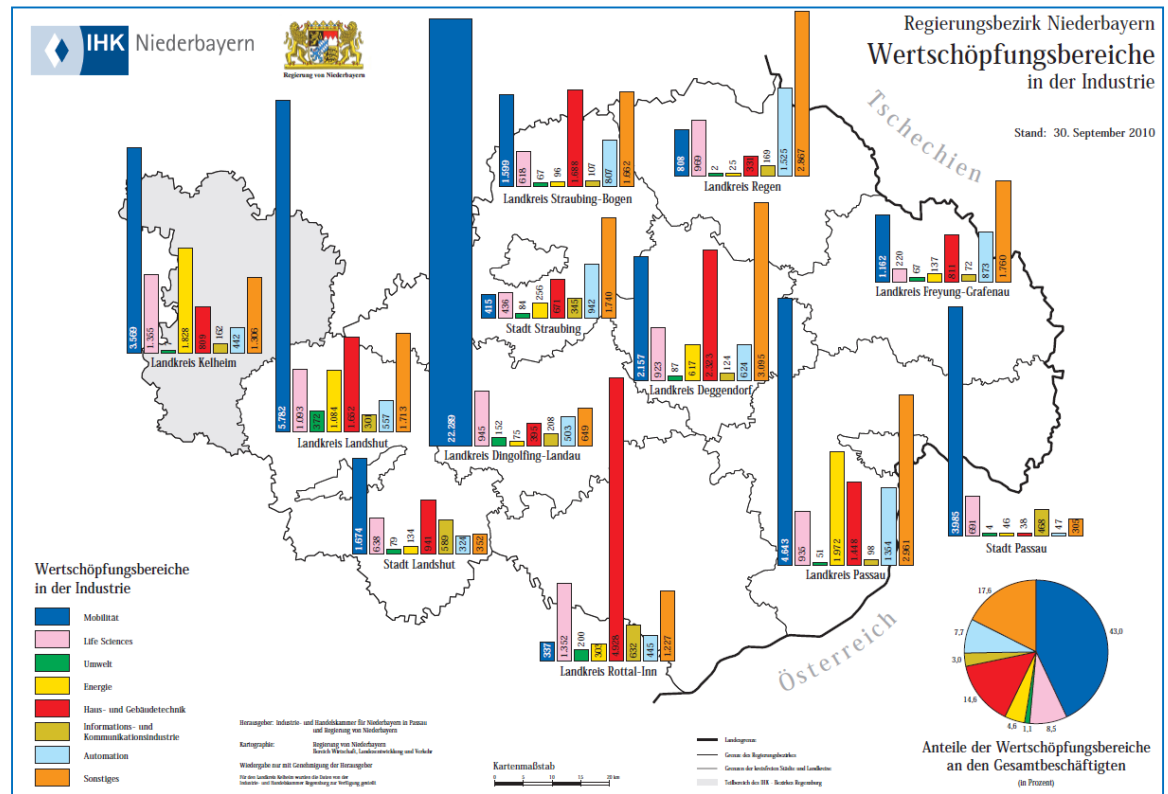

All these study courses offer our students the opportunity to acquire subject-related as well as social, process, system and entrepreneurial competencies.



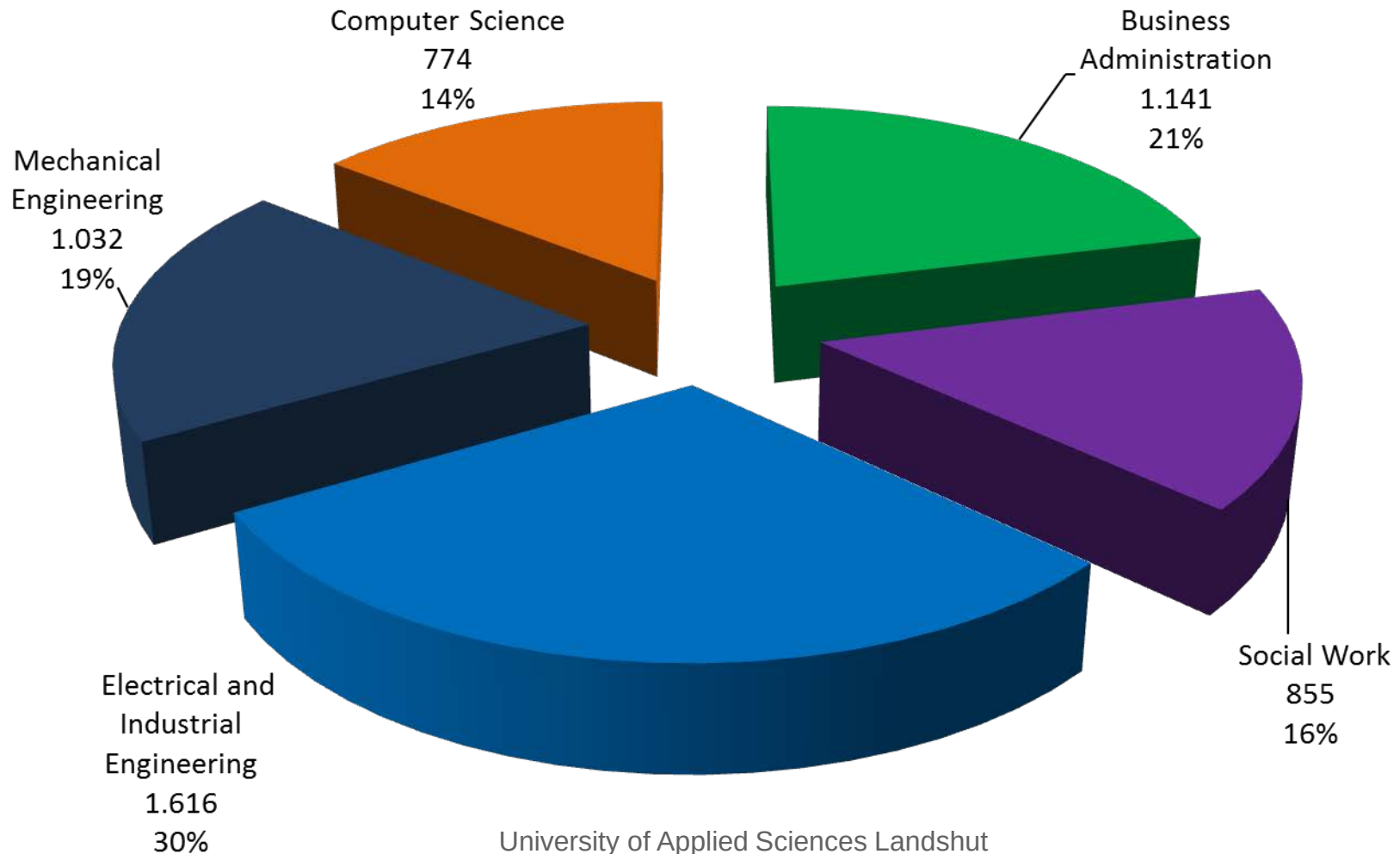

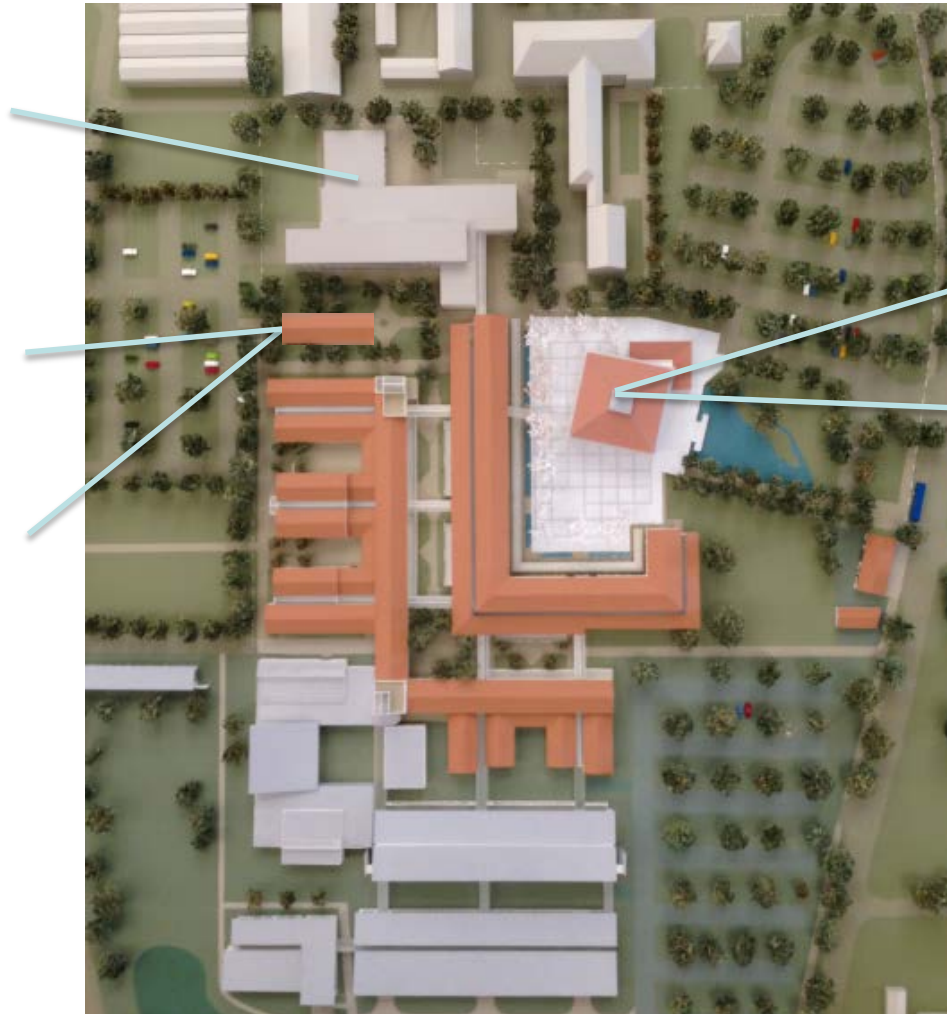

- the Language Centre offers students the possibility to study any of the following eleven languages: German (as foreign language), English, French, Spanish, Italian, Chinese, Turkish, Russian, Swedish, Japanese, Brazilian Portuguese
- about 1,100 students take part in courses each semester



- Open to all members of UAS Landshut; the library can be used 24 hours a day: study in the library, check-out and return of mediums
- large textbook library: all books that will be recommended in the lectures are available in many units
- free loan of e-book-readers and iPads
- 84,000 volumes and 260 periodicals cover the subjects Engineering, Computer Science, Business Administration and Social Work
- 30,000 e-books and 25,000 electronic journals
